Bachelor of Science in Business Administration	The cohort was created from the Fall 2013 dataset utilized for all federal reporting of graduation rates. Students are bachelor’s degree seeking, first-time freshman, that are enrolled full-time. The Graduation date was compared to the start date of the student's first course to calculate the completions within 4 years and 6 years. Below is a copy of the graduation rate definition from IPEDS for greater clarification concerning the methodology implemented in this summary.
Master of Business Administration	Cohort was established by looking at the first graduate course student took at OCU. All students with graduate transfer credit were not included within this cohort. Graduation date was compared to the
