- Flexible Lamp
- Throw Rug
- Posters
- Picture Frames
- String or Rope Lighting

Laundry & Linens to Bring:

- Laundry Bag/Basket
- Laundry Detergent
- Clothing Hangers
- Stain Remover

Appliances to Bring:

- Small Refrigerator (no larger than 5 Cu ft)

Hygiene Products to Bring:

- Shower Caddy
- Soap/ Shampoo/ Conditioner

- Hair Dryer/Curling Iron/Flat Iron/Styling products
- Shower Shoes/Robe
- Tylenol/ Cough & Cold Medicine
- Hand Sanitizer
- Face Mask (disposable or non)
- Small first aid kit

Miscellaneous Items to Consider Bringing:

- Health Insurance Info/Medications
- Cleaning Supplies: dish soap, Clorox wipes, etc.

- Written List of Emergency Contacts
- Board Games
- Deck of Cards

Things You SHOULD NOT Bring:

- Hot Plates
- Older Model Space Heaters
- Electric Skillets
- Toasters or Toaster Ovens
- Candles/Incense
- Firearms, Fireworks/Explosives
- Alcohol Decorations and Illegal Drugs/Paraphernalia
- Pets
- Street Signs
