Even in the courses that didn't use outside programs (such as McGraw-Hill) it seemed that the responses to essays/ papers/ assignments was the exact same for each assignment for every student. If you submitted an assignment you were almost guaranteed a passing grade with a comment similar to -"You have exhibited a defined and clear understanding of the assignment"... "You have demonstrated proficient command of the subject matter in the assignment"..."You have provided comprehensive analysis of details, facts, and concepts in a logical sequence." I received these same remarks on multiple assignments, to the point where I question if most of my assignments were ever even read. I hate to complain that the courses were too easy, because it certainly helped to earn my degree while balancing life, work, and school, but there was little to be learned over the 2 years. There has to be better ways of teaching online courses so that the information is being taught rather than allowing students to re-take the same quiz multiple times until they have memorized the answers in order to pass. If all it takes is transferring grades from one program to the OCU site without ever grading assignments, interacting with students, or actually teaching-- then please tell me how to become an online professor.




