The Graduation date was compared to the start date of the student's first course to calculate the completions within 4 years and 6 years. | Bachelor of Applied Science in Operations Management | The cohort was created from a dataset of Fall 2018 and S2018-2019 full-time undergraduate students (transfers included) utilized for all federal reporting of graduation rates. The cohort was established by looking at the first undergraduate course the student took during Fall 2018. The graduation date was compared to the start date of the student's first course during Fall 2018 to calculate the completions within 4 years and 6 years. | |
| Master of Business Administration/Master of Science in Strategic Management | The cohort was established by looking at the first graduate course students took at OCU. All students with graduate transfer credit were not included within this cohort. Graduation date was compared to the start date of the student's first course to calculate the completions within 2 years and 3 years. | |

Higher Education Act, amended (2008). Graduation rates data are collected for full-time, first-time degree and certificate-seeking undergraduate students. Data collected include: (a) Number of students entering the institution as full-time, first-time degree or certificate-seeking students in a particular year (cohort), by race/ethnicity and gender; (b) Number of students completing their program within a time period equal to one and a half times (150%) the normal period of time, by race/ethnicity, gender, and Pell status; and (c) Number of students who transferred to other institutions.
